# The Story of Smith Farm Goat Sanctuary

The sanctuary land has been in the Smith Family for over 100 years. William E. Smith and his wife built their home on the farm in the early 1900's. For decades, he raised hogs; however, in the early '90s, Mr. Smith brought goats to the farm, quickly falling in love with their quirky personalities, and maintaining a haven for them until he passed. For the past 20+ years, the goats of Smith Farm have been lovingly cared for by Jason, a dedicated friend of the Smith Family and the goats' biggest fan.

Jason dreamed of transforming Smith Farm Goat Sanctuary into a true haven for not just goats, but all kinds of farm animals in need. Today, our sanctuary is home to 53 sweet, happy goats who enjoy their days simply being adorable companions—they aren't used for anything except spreading joy!

We became an official 501c3 nonprofit in December 2024 and have rescued 17 goats as of August 2025. Our sanctuary's mission is to rescue and provide a lifelong sanctuary for goats and possibly other farm animals in the future, preserve and celebrate a part of Fuquay Varina's farming history, and offer inclusive, fun, and family friendly events & programs for the community!
